



Schengen Visas are valid for the following 26 countries:

Austria, Belgium, Czech Republic, Denmark, Estonia, Finland, France, Germany, Greece, Hungary, Iceland, Italy, Latvia, Liechtenstein, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Malta, The Netherlands, Norway, Poland, Portugal, Slovakia, Slovenia, Spain, Sweden, Switzerland

A Schengen Visa is not appropriate if you wish to remain in a Schengen member state longer than 90 days on a period of 180 days or take up employment or establish a business or practice a profession.

Where to apply for a Schengen visa:

If you are not a resident of Oman you should apply to the Embassy or Consulate in your country of residence.

You have to apply at the Visa Services of the European country of your main destination (normally it is the country of the longest visit). Under no circumstances a country where you wish to make transit can be considered the country of main destination. If a main destination can not be determined you have to apply at the Embassy of the country of first entry.

## BUSINESS VISA

### Documents required for Schengen Visa application for: SPAIN, AUSTRIA, FINLAND, LITHUANIA, MALTA, and SLOVENIA

- Filled in application form, duly signed by the applicant(s). You must answer all the questions, otherwise your application will not be accepted. Both legal guardians must sign the application of minors.  
A recent colour passport size photo with white background (gents with uncovered head) has to be stuck to the application form.
- Original and photocopy of passport or official travel document (non-Omani applicants have to have a residence permit issued on their current valid passport):
  - Omani nationals: photocopy of page with the personal data and previous visas.
  - Non-Omani nationals: photocopy of pages with the personal data (and other relevant pages), previous visas and the Omani residence visa.All passports have to have been issued during the previous 10 years and should be valid for at least 3 months longer than the validity of the visa applied for.
- Photocopy (full page) of your medical insurance (covering 30.000,00 €) including repatriation from any Schengen State in case of emergency. The medical insurance has to cover all your stay in all Schengen States.
- Photocopy (full page) of your booking of return ticket.
- Proof of accommodation.
- Economic means for ALL APPLICANTS: Bank statement for the last 6 months and salary certificate.
- An original letter of invitation from the European company inviting you is required. The letter has also to be e-mailed from the inviting company directly to the Embassy ([emb.mascate@maec.es](mailto:emb.mascate@maec.es)).  
For business visits to Slovenia: Official Guarantee Letter from the inviting person/company certified by the Slovenian Authorities or Notary Public.
- A letter of the local company (sponsor for Non-Omani nationals) identifying the applicant and explaining the purpose of his visit.

### PLEASE NOTE:

During the examination of a visa application, some additional documents may be requested in order to determine that all requirements to obtain the visa are met.

Also, a Spanish translation of all submitted documents may be required in accordance to the provisions of Article 15 of the Act 39/2015 on the Spanish Common Administrative Procedure.

In some cases, a personal interview with an applicant may also be requested.
